

## Registry Membership

With a **free** Gateways Registry Membership, your education, credentials, and all Registry trainings you have attended will be tracked in the Registry database. You can access this information at any time by viewing your Professional Development Record (PDR) online through a secure section of this website.

Joining the Gateways Registry is EASY! You can either:

- Complete and submit **the application online**, or
- **Print and mail** the application

If you apply online it can take up to 2 business days (but during business hours, it is typically within 10 minutes) for your user account to be approved before you can complete your online application. Once your application is complete you have access to i-learning and your Registry Portal immediately.

If you print and mail your application, within 30 days you will receive an email with login information to the Registry portal.

From the Registry portal you can print a membership ID card and view your PDR. Check out **a sample PDR**.





# Introducción a INCCRRA

**¿Qué/Quién es INCCRRA?** - La Red de Agencias de Referencias y Recursos de Cuidado Infantil de Illinois (Illinois Network of Child Care Resource and Referral Agencies, INCCRRA) es una organización que funciona en todo el estado que, en asociación con sus 16 agencias locales de Recursos y Referencias de Cuidado Infantil (Child Care Resources and Referral, CCR&R), es un líder reconocido y catalizador con recursos para proveer las opciones de atención y educación temprana y de cuidado en edad escolar que sean de alta calidad y asequibles para niños y familias en Illinois.

# Introducción a Gateways

**Gateways to Opportunity®** Gateways to Opportunity es un sistema de apoyo para el desarrollo profesional que abarca todo el estado diseñado para brindar orientación, estímulo y reconocimiento a personas y programas que sirven a niños, jóvenes y familias. Gateways to Opportunity se administra a través de la INCCRRA y está financiado por el Department of Human Services Bureau of Child Care and Development, la Fundación McCormick y la Grand Victoria Foundation.

# Registro de Desarrollo Profesional (PDR)

## Professional Development Record

The Gateways Registry Professional Development Record (PDR) is a benefit available to all Registry Members. It can be accessed by logging in to the Registry Dashboard and entering the My Registry portal. The PDR is located in the Learn section and can be run for any date range. Check out [a sample PDR](#).

The PDR has six sections which list your education, credentials, and Registry trainings.

- Education and Credentials - Sections 1 and 2
- Gateways Registry Trainings - Sections 3, 4, and 5
- Self-Reported Training - Section 6

When you attend a Gateways Registry training, be sure to sign in using your Registry Member ID. The training will appear on your PDR (in Section 3, 4, or 5) a few days later. It's that simple!

### Basic Transcript Review

The Gateways Basic Transcript Review (BTR) records the total number of credit hours earned from an accredited college or university and displays the information on the PDR. The BTR process further categorizes applicable coursework, completed with a grade of "C" or better, into four categories:

- ECE/CD
- ECE-Related
- School-Age and Youth Development
- Business/Administration

The BTR is completed on all official transcripts received by the Gateways Registry. Official transcripts are those sealed in an envelope and sent from an accredited college or university. They may also be sent electronically from an accredited college or university to [transcripts@inccrra.org](mailto:transcripts@inccrra.org).

Foreign evaluated transcripts and coursework will only be accepted from entities listed as a [National Association of Credential Evaluation Services \(NACES\) member](#).

Upon completion of the review, your formal education will be reflected on your Professional Development Record (PDR) in sections 1 and 2.


